POLICY BULLETIN NO. 67C

SUBJECT: Renewable Energy Credit Service

POLICY:

Subject to availability, Members shall have the opportunity to designate that all or part of their electric load be served by a renewable generation resource through the purchase of Renewable Energy Credits (RECs).

I. Availability

RECs are available to Members who purchase electrical service from the Cooperative under an applicable rate schedule. RECs will be made available to the Members of the Cooperative on a first-come, first-serve basis. Members may choose to purchase RECs in blocks of 100 kWhs each or elect to have their entire load served by RECs.

II. Definitions

Renewable Generation Resource. Generation Resources that are fueled by landfill gas, wind, solar, geothermal, bio-mass, wave, micro-hydro or other similar generation resource approved by the Cooperative.

Renewable Energy Credit(s). A tradable certificate of proof that one kWh of electricity has been produced from a Renewable Generation Resource. Credits are denominated in kWhs and are a separate commodity from the power itself.

PROCEDURE:

Members may choose to subscribe to one or more (100 kWh) blocks of RECs for a flat rate or they may elect to have their entire retail load served by RECs at an adjusted rate per kWh purchased. All other applicable rate schedule charges still apply.

MONTHLY RATE ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS DESIGNATING BLOCKS:

\$2.00 per 100 kWh block. (Members may purchase multiple blocks)

MONTHLY RATE ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS DESIGNATING ENTIRE RETAIL LOAD:

Energy Charge.....Applicable energy rate plus \$0.01 per kWh

MINIMUM MONTHLY CHARGES:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Minimum Monthly Charge of the applicable rate schedule.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Board of Directors, General Manager, Manager of Member Services, and Director of Member Services
