POLICY BULLETIN NO. 72E

SUBJECT: New Large Single Loads (NLSLs)

POLICY:

AVAILABILITY: To Members of the Cooperative subject to the established Bylaws, Policies, rules and regulations of the Cooperative.

APPLICABILITY: For any new load whose power requirements are greater than 1 aMW of energy in any consecutive 12-month period or 1 MW of demand and for the expansion of an existing load at a single facility whose power requirements increase by 1 aMW of energy or more in any consecutive 12-month period or 1 MW of demand as compared to the immediately preceding 12-month period.

The Cooperative will determine the start date for measuring the consecutive 12-month period for applicability of this policy. Either the date initially energized or the commencement of commercial operation will be selected, whichever results in the highest energy use.

A new or expanded load will be treated as a NLSL if it consists of one or more distinct loads which meet each of the following criteria:

- Geographically located adjacent to each other;
- Metered jointly or separately;
- Involve or support similar manufacturing processes or products or commercial activities as determined by the Cooperative.

If a new load or expansion of an existing load was initially determined by the Cooperative to not be a NLSL and was billed at the applicable rate schedule, but such load is later determined to be a NLSL, the Cooperative will begin billing consistent with the NLSL methodology described below as soon as such determination is made.

A load is not a NLSL if it moves from one location to another within the Cooperative's service territory and does not increase its power requirements as described above.

MONTHLY RATES:

If a new or expanded load is determined to be a NLSL the rate will be determined by the Board of Directors taking into consideration the cost to serve the NLSL including, but not limited to, the wholesale cost of power, transmission service, and distribution service.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Board of Directors, General Manager, Manager of Engineering, and Director of Member Services.

PROCEDURE:

As outlined in the above written policy.
