POLICY BULLETIN NO. 84

SUBJECT: Transformer Installations

POLICY:

The Cooperative will strive to provide the Member with the required transformer capacity deemed adequate to deliver their estimated load requirements at a satisfactory voltage and in accordance with good utility practices.

RESPONSIBILITY: Manager of Engineering and Manager of Operations

PROCEDURE:

1. Transformer Capacity Required – The term “required transformer capacity” , shall be defined as the manufacturer’s standardized nameplate capacity in kVA, which most nearly equals that required to carry the Member’s estimated maximum load. The Cooperative may install larger transformers than actually required.

2. Transformer Changes – Transformer changes shall be made, as is practical, in all cases where it has been determined that the capacity is not adequate to deliver a Member’s load at a satisfactory voltage. The Cooperative may charge the Member the cost associated with the transformer change including but not limited to labor, material, and overheads.
